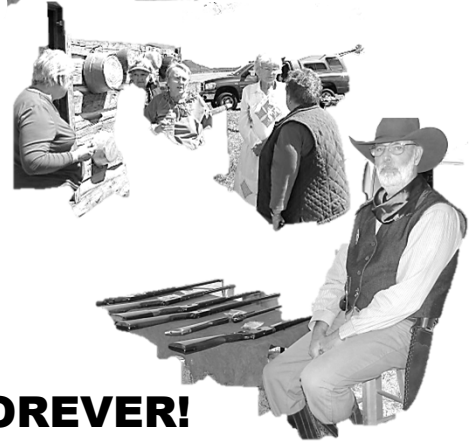

GPS NAVIGATORS

Crull-Hammond Cabin address is 6225 Bear Dance Drive, Larkspur, CO 80104.

DRIVING SOUTH FROM CASTLE ROCK

At Castle Rock from I-25, Exit 181: Take the I-25 west frontage road for approximately 5 miles to Tomah Road, turn right for 0.8 miles, take the first left at Bear Dance Drive, travel 1.8 mi on Bear Dance Drive, Crull-Hammond Cabin is on right.

DRIVING NORTH FROM LARKSPUR

From I-25 north of Larkspur, Take I-25 Exit 174: Turn left toward Tomah Road (0.3 miles), turn right onto I-25 West Frontage Road, travel 2.1 miles to Tomah Road intersection, turn left for 0.8 miles, take the first left at Bear Dance Drive, travel 1.8 mi on Bear Dance Drive, Crull-Hammond Cabin is on right.
